



Serrapetrona aqueduct: clear water from mountain springs







The aqueduct of Monte San Pietrangeli



The aqueduct that serves Monte San Pietrangeli, called Tennacola, was built in 1903. It served 21 municipalities at that time. In 1915 five other areas were added. Nowadays it serves 26 municipalities in the provinces of Fermo and Macerata.





The water is particularly clear as it comes from a spring in the Sibillini national park



Once the Fonte Maggiore of Macerata, built by the architect Marcolfo in the XIV century, was the best water tank of the city, around which a lot of people gathered every day. It had well distributed spaces: the canals, pools and fountains served as a watering place for animals, as a wash basin and as a water supply. The captain Francesco Sforza, who besieged Macerata in 1433, redesigned a part of the walls excluding it, to deprive citizens of a precious resource and better control the town in the event of a siege .

Corridonia's main square contains the monument to the hero Philip Corridoni, the town hall and, on the northern side, the war memorial with a marble fountain, built by Oddo Aliverti, in "rationalistic style" in the fascist period.

This fountain was originally placed in the centre of Piazza XX Settembre, the main square of Civitanova Marche. Following the creation of the gardens, the fountain was moved to the center of the new green space
